
Windows E-Mail keeps Evolving

- Windows XP added Outlook Express for Free
- Microsoft Office included Outlook
- Windows 7 to Win 11 introduced Mail
- Windows 11 replaces Mail with (new)Outlook
- Online Version also called Outlook
- Early versions saved emails to local storage
- Now all email saved to online account

File Format Changes

- Emails downloaded were stored in one .pst file
- Now downloaded emails are individual .eml files
- Most services keep the email on the server
- Connection method is "Internet Message Access Protocol" IMAP
- Average message size is under 100 kB


You Have Two Ways to View Email

- 1. Use your Browser Chrome, Edge, Firefox to go to the email account logon and enter credentials. Outlook, Gmail, Yahoo, AOL or any others.
- ▶ 2. Use the Windows "Outlook" app and add each email account.
- ▶ 3. All email remains on the server and counts as part of your free storage.

Free Cloud Storage


- Google Drive 15GB free with document collaboration 100GB @ \$2/per month
- OneDrive 5GB free cloud storage but with a 100GB file size limit. 50GB @ \$1/Month
- Amazon AWS 5GB of free space with great security and privacy. 100GB @ \$2/Month
- <u>Dropbox</u> 2GB free with good syncing capabilities. 2000GB @ \$10/Month
- iCloud Drive 5GB free online storage for Apple users. 50GB @ \$1/Month

Windows Outlook Program

- Outlook is the successor to Outlook Express and Mail and is an IMAP client.
- When you open it, it requests from the server a LIST of your email, showing sender and subject.
- When you click on a message, a temporary copy is sent to you; it is discarded if you click on another.
- ▶ The design mimics that of the online version.
- Its features are continuing to evolve.

When you click on an individual message, MAIL requests a temporary copy of the email and displays it in the message pane.



Adding Accounts

You can have multiple email accounts and each can be added to the Mail program.



If you wish, you can combine all the inboxes to a unified inbox.

The Folders are storage for the selected account (see white bar) and "More" shows names of each.

- File System for Email

The New Outlook

- Pluses:
 - Web and Desktop look similar
 - Supported program New Features
- Minuses:
 - Looks different than you may be used to
 - Missing Features
 - · Spam handling still not good
 - Best to block senders through web version
 - No Unified Inbox
 - · New icons to learn
